ROSE Remembrance Day KICK OFF

For the past 56 years the first Saturday in October has been known as Rose Remembrance Day in Summit County. And this as the 57th year is no different.

Kick off dinner. card the name of the Club or individual who is selling them is noted so that you will receive the proper credit for each dozen sold. If ordering on line you will also need to not the club or individual selling the roses.

Orders for Roses as well as the money should be turned in on a **weekly basis**. The Portage Lakes Kiwanis Rose Office will be open on a daily basis starting on:

9-28 from 8am to 3pm

9-30 from 8am to 6pm and on 10-1 thru 10-4 from 8am - 7pm.

Roses are to be delivered to the Portage Lakes Kiwanis Civic Center on Saturday October 5th around 6am and shortly thereafter we will start putting them in individual vehicles for delivery. Delivery times will start at 8:00 am. For any missed delivery's we will have a RE- Delivery date of
