The Chimney Swift is a federally protected migratory bird which traditionally nested in residential and commercial chimneys. With the reduced number of chimneys in new construction the birds are losing vital habitat. By building this artificial chimney, this will enhance the nesting and breeding of the local Chimney Swift population.
