On Saturday November 4th our club will hold a Quarter Auction fundraiser at the Barberton Moose which is on 31st Street in Barberton. We will have local vendors like Color Street, Pampered Chef, Scentsy, etc to be present to sell their wares and each will be asked to donate a basket to be raffled off. How the auction works: You will bid on quality vendor raffle baskets with one to four quarters, depending on the retail value. Bids are then collected in the basket provided and you hold your paddle up. A randomly chosen number is called. If the person with that paddle number placed a bid, he or she wins the item. Numbers will continue to be drawn until there is a basket winner.
